

Dear Higher and Further Education Minister, Chair of Court, and UEG representatives,

In response to the most recent events, including the “resignation” of the Principal of the University of Dundee, the failure to provide financial data and disclose the recovery plan, as well as the cancellation of two scheduled extraordinary Local Joint Committee meetings, the Dundee UCU, Unison and UNITE branches demand that the remaining members of UEG meaningfully engage in consultation with us, as the recognised voices of staff in the University.

In the spirit of the statement from the Minister for Higher and Further Education, Graeme Dey, we also request that redundancies are avoided at all cost.

We urgently request a meeting with the Chair of Court and the Minister for Higher and Further Education. We are keen to work with Court and the Scottish Government to resolve the financial crisis faced by the University of Dundee, but we can do so only if we are fully briefed and involved in the conversation.
