







Notes

Considerably drier in total, with a reduction of 176.6 mm (from 241.2 to 64.6). This month's rainfall is less than half the average of the previous 3 years. Rainfall was largely confined to the period 8th-18th March, the weather then giving way to dry conditions for the remainder of the month.

Warmer than February, increasing from -0.2 degree to 2.1 degrees on average, a 2.3 degree change.

Increased sunshine hours compared to February, the daily average rising from 2.5 to 4.8, giving an increased monthly total of 150.2 compared with 69.7 hours. For Scotland nationally, the Met Office reported more sunshine than in any March since 1919.

6 instances of freezing soil temperatures and 14 instances of freezing air temperatures. Only 4 instances of ground temperature being higher than air temperature. Limited snow cover detected.
