With over 1,000 infected people, government declares health emergency and announces social distancing measures. All non-essential activities frozen from 30th March to 30th April in the public and private sectors. No curfews nor compulsory mobility restrictions on citizens implemented. It is advised to isolate at home voluntarily.

Mandatory quarantine measures. 30-day self-isolation (for suspected cases) and confiscation of vehicles in case of having failed to comply with mandatory household quarantine. Mandatory to wear masks whenever outside. Mainly food and pharmaceutical industries are allowed to operate

Measures endorsed by the Government



Borders have been closed and curfew. Wearing protective masks outside home and inside close spaces is mandatory. No mobility is allowed Saturday and Sunday. Only 2 persons per vehicle are allowed and only one of those persons is allowed in the establishments. Non-compliance with this measure is subject to the confiscation of the vehicle for the duration of this emergency, as well as the detention of the persons on board for up to 24 hours.
