- Only Brazilians at high risk should be isolated.

- Construction and manufacturing sectors have been allowed to work according to safety measures.
- Citizens can now exercise from 5 a.m to 8 a.m.
- Mandatory quarantine will continue until the 11th of May.

Measures endorsed by the Government



- Mobility restrictions and social distancing measures continue in place.
- The government announced the country will be back to "normal" on the 4th of May. This will be a gradual process with measures announced by the president on the 24th of April.

Measures endorsed by the Government



- Quarantine measures and border closures in place.
- Movement restrictions include from Monday to Saturday only one person per family (regardless of gender) may drive for grocery shopping, pharmacy visits, and banking.
