Measures endorsed by the Government



- Movement continues to be restricted nationwide, with quarantine measures extended to 10 May.
- One person per household (between the ages of 18 and 65) is allowed to go outside to buy food, once per week between the hours of 7am and 12 midday. No private or public vehicles can circulate, except those related to security and health.
- Penalties for breaching these conditions include fines and imprisonment.

Measures endorsed by the Government



- Governors of Sao Paulo and Rio de Janeiro will extend the partial quarantine measures in force since March until the end of May.
- The pandemic has given rise to ongoing governmental clashes, pitting the president against governors and mayors who have implemented social distancing and confinement measures to contain the virus' spread-efforts supported by the country's Supreme Court.

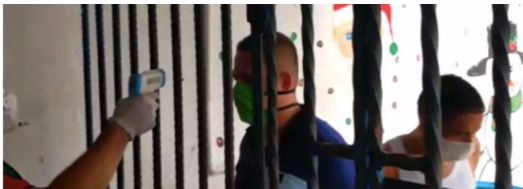

- A new list with activities that have exceptions from the lockdown has been released by the government.

Measures endorsed by the Government



- On the 4th May Ecuador initiated 'a new normality'.
- A 'traffic light system' is currently under place to reactivate the country. In this system, restrictions are loosen depending on the color: red indicating the more stringent measures and green allowing for greater mobility.

Measures endorsed by the Government



- Quarantine measures and border closures.
- Peruvian quarantine movement restrictions stipulate that from Monday to Saturday, only one person per family (regardless of gender), may conduct limited routine business such as grocery shopping, pharmacy visits, and banking. Extended until 24 May.

Measures endorsed by the Government



- On Sunday, April 12, the Venezuelan government extended the ongoing "social quarantine" measures for an additional 30 days.
- The measures, which were introduced on Tuesday, March 17, will continue to apply to all 23 states and the capital Caracas.
- It is mandatory to use a face mask in all public spaces since Sunday, March 22. Venezuela's police force has also been deployed to ensure public compliance with the quarantine measures.
