Opposite each entry is a 3 x 3 symbol matrix. Here is an example:

Each position in the symbol matrix contains the coded answer(s) to a question. The position of the 9 questions in the matrix is as follows:

Key to the coded answers is on the facing page.

Once you know what answer you are looking for, find out the appropriate symbol and matrix position. Now scan the index looking for it. This is the fastest retrieval system we could come up with for a mass of different information.

This form of index is devised to be of use to persons actually looking for something, rather than for dilettantes to browse through. So the reaction to it is predictable, and criticism of the project as a whole will come mainly from professional critics. Well, tough shit to you.

On the other hand, the index is not really comprehensive, and some of the information is already out of date. If you are a contributor, please check your entry for corrections and return a better version to us in time for the next edition (likely Nov 73). If you would like to be included, send us your entry.
