Dear Steve Partridge:


Thanks for your letter and the invitation to participate in the first Coventry Festival of Video Art. I am delighted to accept. At the moment I am not quite sure which tapes to send. I will be producing a new tape "Thin Air" in February and could include that, also perhaps an older tape called "Moving a camera in contact with a girl's body" and another very short (10 second) piece called "Sto/ol" that plays over and over again on a half hour tape. Alternatively the piece C.V.A. already has might be suitable.

As to the nomination of other artists, my own choice is quite clear: Colin Campbell, Noel Harding, and Lisa Steele. All are with Art Metropole in Toronto, and I think it would be best to reach them c/o that address as they all changed their private addresses recently. In the meantime I am sending copies of my letter and your letter to them.
