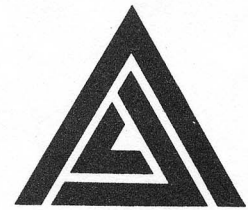

I have been meaning to contact you for some time now about our forthcoming video exhibition at the Serpentine Gallery.
