Terry Flaxton has been active in the Art, Communications, Sound, Light, Vision, and Television areas since 1979. Prior to this his work led him through most of the traditional forms of art. He has established a reputation for innovative and experimental work with a distinctive edge which has made him a popular British artist especially in Europe, but also on the other continents - for instance, he had a retrospective in Kuala Lumpur in 1991.

His work has been screened at all of the major festivals including Montbeliard, the Worldwide video Festival, Los Angeles AFI, Sydney, Copenhagen, Montreal and Tokyo, and won prizes at many. He has had his work screened on various television networks including Channel 4, ITV, BBC1 and BBC2 in Great Britain, PBS, KABC, KQED, WTTW, WGBH, MTV and WNET in America, Canal Plus in France, SBS and ABC in Australia.

Though his work has at times taken on formal concerns, he has a firm belief that Art can be accessible to the viewer if the artist takes that extra step *towards* them. This requires an attitude of clarity and rigourousness beyond the concerns of either the market, the critical institutions or the funding institutions that govern most of the work produced in the non-painting non-sculpture areas.

He has recently had a retrospective in Paris and is two-thirds of the way through a major long form work entitled: The Colour Myths which explores the nature of meaning. I am currently finishing a major work: THE COLOUR MYTHS which is a seven part video art work which began with a Channel 4 commission called THE INEVITABILITY OF COLOUR. I have currently completed 3 parts, and I have shot the last 4. I have will post produce these in 1994.
